Box tops for education- Clip box tops from participating products and it turns into cash for our school. A list of participating products and collection sheets will be sent home at the beginning of the school year. Throughout the year, collection sheets will be sent home for students to fill and return. Collect all summer long and return at the beginning of the school year. Students participating have the chance to win great prizes and awards.



Campbell's labels for Education- This program is ran almost like the box tops program. You will receive a list of participating products along with collection sheets. This program offers in exchange for the labels, art and music supplies, and equipment for Physical education classes, computers, and several other school supplies for classrooms. Again, students participating have the chance to win great prizes and awards.



Capri Sun juice pouches- Wash them out and send these in! We receive 2 cents for every one we return for recycling. With approximately 285 students attending Edgewood, you would be surprised how the money adds up!
